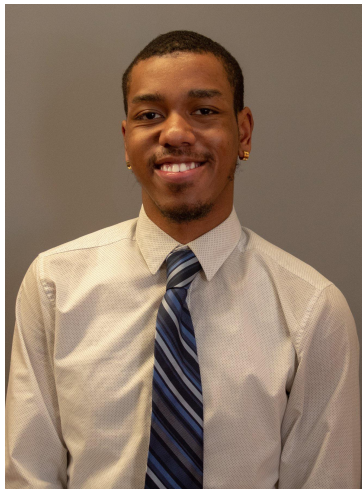

PROGRAM OUTLINE

- The event will take place in October (during spring course registration).
- A partnership with New Student Orientation and Student Outreach and Support offices has been established.
- Students are asked to take part in a virtual resource hunt.
- During this event, they are asked to find pertinent information (discussed later) on the university's website about resources provided to students.
- The resource search lists will be tailored to the student's current class standing (first year, senior, etc.).
- They are also required to attend 3 important virtual meetings/ events: 1 academic advising session, 2 university hosted virtual events of their choice.
- Deadline to complete each item is November 1st.



INCENTIVE THEORY OF MOTIVATION

- By providing students with an external reward, our event will encourage learning and interaction.

TIMELINE OF EVENTS

- October 1st- First email communication is sent to students by Student Outreach and Support Services
- October 14th- Spring registration opens for undergraduate students
- October 15th- Reminder Email is sent, along with a list of virtual event opportunities for students to attend.
- November 1st- Resource Hunt submission deadline
- November 2nd- Students will be emailed with instructions on how to claim their participation winnings, and will be asked to submit a post-event survey.



ASSESSMENT: SURVEY OF THE PROGRAM

Targeted Population: Student who participated in the Resource Search

Timeline: November 2nd- the day after the Resource search is complete

Method: Google Forms

- Participants will be given the opportunity to provide open ended feedback about their experience.
- Participants will be asked 5 questions about the knowledge gained (if any) during their search.

The results will be used to determine if the Resource Search should continue in future years, and to implement improvements.
